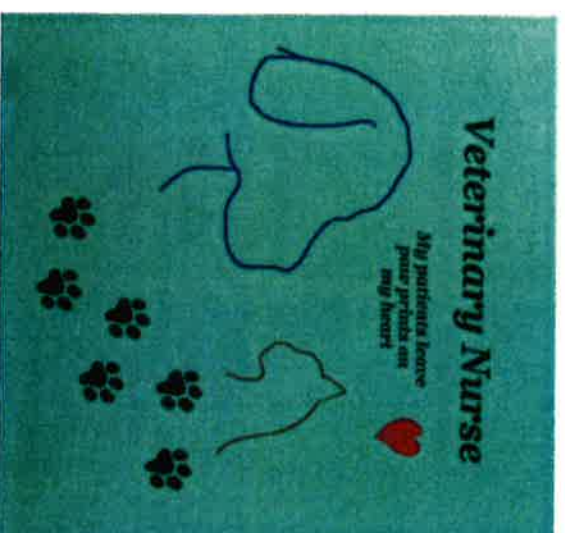


Skills focus for this term:
